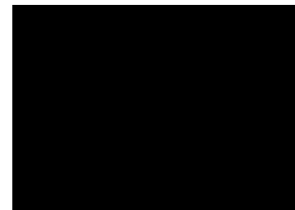
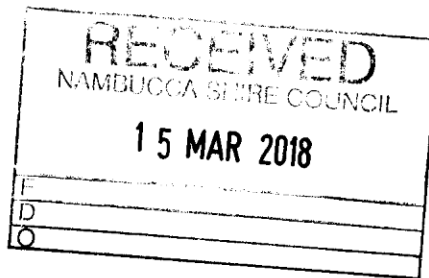

Re: Memorial Wall at Scotts Head

During 2017 the local church was sold and is now a residential property.

The result of this is that now there is nowhere in Scotts Head for people to display a plaque or any other item as a memorial of friends or relatives who have passed away either in Scotts Head or who's ashes have been cast into the ocean at Scotts.

A few of my friends have suggested that I write to council with the idea that a memorial wall be built near one of the headlands.

This idea is an alternative to the provision of a remembrance park in the old cricket ground near the bowling club, proposed in the caravan park redevelopment plan several years ago.
