

Description of organisation –

The Fiji Project was established in 2016 and has since been operating as an independent international aid initiative.

For the past three years my passion has been to positively influence the lives of students living in remote regions of Fiji. 'The Fiji Project' works closely with disadvantaged Fijian schools. Through the introduction of educational workshops that teach students about physical and mental health issues, my initiative has significantly improved the quality of life and wellbeing for these students.

The goal for 2019 is to improve the educational outcomes for these students, consequently optimising their social and academic potential through the development of a Student Learning Centre at Nawai Secondary School in Fiji. This facility will be the first of its kind in Fiji. The Student Learning centre will be a state of the art facility for students to study and learn.

On my most recent trip to Fiji I have developed a relationship with an Orphanage called 'The Treasure House'. This Orphanage provides a safe and secure home for countless orphaned children who are unfortunately without families. The Treasure house now operates with financial assistance from The Fiji Project.

I am confident that this valuable experience will positively change the outlook of Australian students who take western luxuries and their education for granted, as it has previously done for me.

Being able to open your mind and hearts to others ultimately has the potential to change ones mindset. Providing this educational cross cultural experience to youth will broaden their awareness of the hardships children struggling in the developing world undergo in order to receive an education. This experience captures the essence of these students' passion and devotion to gain an education and inevitably raises the value that Australian students have for their own education. This initiative aims to nurture passionate students that strive for excellence.

As well as having multiple educational benefits these expeditions significantly strengthen community spirit and have additional potential benefits for local youth. Volunteering cultivates social networking, support and builds relationships. It also connects individuals who are working collectively towards a mutual goal.

Improved mental health is another of the many benefits of volunteering. Mental health is a major issue confronting today's youth. Feelings of happiness and accomplishment associated with helping other have the capability of relieving individual's internal struggles, whilst developing emotional stability and improving self-esteem.

Reverse humanitarianism; a process in which providing assistance to other humans in order to better humanity morally, consequently enables individuals to achieve transcendence within themselves. This being the fundamental object of the prospective educational enlightenment tours reflect its gratifying and rewarding nature.
