Horses (mare, stallion, gelding, colt, filly, foal, hinny, mule, donkey and ass)

Recommended number:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A stocking rate of 1 per 2.5 hectares (a minimum of 5 hectares is recommended).
Recommended requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep animals a minimum of 9 metres from a dwelling, school, shop, office, factory, workshop, church or other place of public worship, public hall or premises used for the manufacture, preparation or storage of food. Locate enclosures at least 20 metres from a dwelling or place where food is kept, processed or stored, or 6 metres from any roadway or 1 metre from any property boundary. Enclose yards to prevent escape. Keep feed in a manner that prevents access by vermin.
Advice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The keeping of hoofed animals above the recommended number may require development consent. Refer to Nambucca LEP 2010 for details. Refer also to management practices for Agriculture - Livestock on the NSW Department of Primary Industries website www.dpi.nsw.gov.au Refer to the keeping of horses and cattle provisions in the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005, Schedule 2, Part 5 - Standards for Keeping Birds or Animals. Recommended number:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prohibited in R1 – R4 and RU5 zones. Maximum of 1 per premise in R5 zones.
Recommended requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swine must not be kept in such a place or manner as to pollute any waterway or water supplied for use (or used, or likely to be used) by a person for drinking or domestic purposes, or in a dairy. Swine's dung must not be deposited in such a place or manner as to pollute any water supplied for use (or used, or likely to be used) by a person for drinking or domestic purposes, or in a dairy. Swine must not be kept (and swine's dung must not be deposited) within 60 metres of a dwelling, shop, office, factory, church or other place of public worship, workshop, school or
