COUNCILLOR JOHN WILSON ELECTED DEPUTY MAYOR

The newly elected Nambucca Valley Council held its first Ordinary Council Meeting on 13 January 2022 with the election of a Deputy Mayor high on the agenda. Two nominations were received from Councillors Susan Jenvey and John Wilson with Councillor John Wilson being elected as Deputy Mayor in a secret ballot.

Councillor Wilson said that it was an honour and a privilege to be endorsed as the Deputy Mayor of Nambucca Valley Council.

“It is also a privilege to work with Mayor Hoban, who has done so much for the Council and the community over an extended period of time, and I will provide whatever assistance I can to try and make her job easier” said Councillor Wilson.

Mayor of Nambucca Valley Council, Councillor Rhonda Hoban, OAM was looking forward to again working with Councillor Wilson which, due to the delayed election, will be a shortened term that concludes in late September this year.
