

RESTRICTED ACCESS

The car parking area and public space adjacent to the Nambucca Heads Surf Life Saving Club building will be closed for the duration of construction activities at the site. Due to the nature of the works, the site will be very dangerous to the public and no unauthorised access is permitted. Works are expected to take a number of months to complete, however Nambucca Valley Council will endeavor to reinstate public access by 24 September 2022.

If the full scope of works are not completed by this date, the area will be partially opened for use during the school holidays.

PROJECT DETAILS

Nambucca Valley Council will be replacing the existing, failing seawall on Nambucca Main Beach with an upgraded seawall. The works will provide for the ongoing safe use and enjoyment of Main Beach by the community and tourists visiting our Valley, while maintaining protection of infrastructure.

The works will consist of upgrading the existing seawall with a new 180m long vertical seawall, incorporating a 40m long concrete bleacher seawall at its southern extent. Ancillary works will include resealing and reconfiguration of the carpark and construction of a pedestrian footpath adjoining the top of the seawall, providing a link from the carpark to the beach access points and Nambucca Surf Life Saving Club. A viewing platform and a new beach shower will also be installed.

This project is co-funded by the Australian and NSW governments through the Bushfire Local Economic Recovery Fund.

TEMPORARY ACCESS MAIN BEACH NAMBUCCA HEADS

Parking - Access

There will limited car parking availability on Headland Drive near Main Beach. The nearest alternate car parking areas are Headland Reserve and Beilby's Beach. The Beilby's Beach car park south of Main Beach can be accessed by Newry Street and is considered the best option for surfers accessing the break.

Swimming Creek car park will also be available and suitable for beach access.

Pedestrian - Access

The Nambucca Surf Life Saving Club and café will remain open to the public as per normal operating hours.

Pedestrian access will be maintained via the footpath on Headland Drive, however parking will be limited.

Alternative pedestrian beach access will be via Beilby's Beach car park, Swimming Creek car park and Headland Reserve car park.

The worksite will be extremely hazardous with pedestrian access to the main section of the beach closed to the public.
