



Reconstruction Project of the Deep Creek Pedestrian Footbridge in Valla Beach

Key points:

- There will be a construction for a 10-week period commencing after the Easter holidays 2024.
- There will be no pedestrian access during construction with a minimum of 20m offset exclusion zone either side of the workzone.
- Structure width:
 - The current structure width is 2m and the current footway width is 1.5m.
 - The proposed overall width is 2m with a footway width of 2m.
- Current height of main footbridge from high tide mark to underside of joist = 1.4m.
- The proposed height will match the existing deck height (not including raised section).
- The proposed alignment will match the existing alignment in accordance with the Crown License for the structure
- \$1.3m Funded via the Community Local Infrastructure Recovery Program

Alternate off leash dog areas include:

- Lions park, also known as Valla reserve
- North Valla Beach – north of the carpark
