The 2017 flood in Lismore saw 7 out of 10 businesses in the CBD suffer damage.

Two months after the flood, 1 in 6 businesses were yet to re-open. Business costs continued, even with their lack of income. Those businesses that were prepared, re-opened within a few days.

So, if you haven't prepared your business for disaster, a disaster could put you out of business.
